# Phishing Alert

Recently there has been a rise in phishing emails that are attempting to get account information from FCU members.

These emails are claiming to come from the NACHA, but are not legitimate emails. They claim that there is a problem with an ACH transaction on your account, and that you need to click on a link to get the problem resolved. Do not click on this link.

This link will actually download a version of the Zeus Trojan virus known as "Gameover" in an attempt to steal your online banking login information. Vigilance is key when it comes to protection your online accounts. Help us help you. If you see any of these emails, either delete or forward to [spoof@fbcu.org](mailto:spoof@fbcu.org) where we can analyze and help with the situation.

Things you should know about our emails:

- We never request personal information via email.
- We never ask you to "verify" information in an email, such as account number or PIN.
- We will never ask you to click on a link to a "special" website to verify or request personal information.
